

# **Christina Tong - Adjudicator**

Christina Tong is an active pianist, chamber musician, adjudicator and educator. She holds a Master of Music degree in performance from McGill University, a Bachelor of Music performance degree from the University of Victoria and an associate performance diploma from the Royal Conservatory of Music. She is currently faculty member and resident collaborative pianist at the Langley Community Music School. Christina has competed and performed in solo, collaborative, and orchestral performances across Canada, winning numerous awards from competitions over the years. Her mentors include renowned pianists Bruce Vogt, Ilya Poletaev, and Jane Coop.

Christina has worked with winners and top finalists at Performing Arts BC, Vancouver Kiwanis Festival, Vancouver Symphony Youth Orchestra competition, and Vancouver Area Youth Arts Festival. She has also collaborated with students and colleagues in the Canadian Music Festival debuting Canadian compositions, as well as performances in Müzewest Concerts, Café Classico, and the Langley Community Music School Scholarship and Awards Festival. In addition to performing, Christina enjoys teaching a full studio and coaching chamber music.




